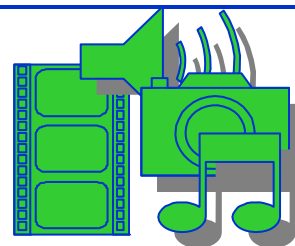

Computer Training @ your library

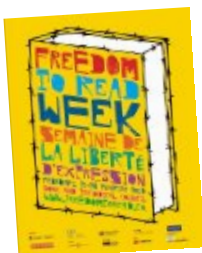


March – May 2010

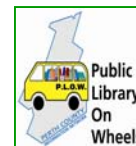
